

## **Adventure 4WD Club of WA – Code of Ethics**

1. Members shall be prepared to conform to majority decisions under the guidance of the Leader whose authority must be accepted at all times. Should it be necessary a Leader shall be empowered to recommend to the Committee of his club that a member or members be banned from future trips or be asked to resign from the Club for refusal to comply with reasonable control.
2. a) there shall be no destruction of trees, shrubs or wildlife, the environment must be protected at all times.  
  
b) All public and private property shall be respected and no wilful trespass shall be permitted.  
  
c) Permissions shall be obtained before entering private property.  
  
d) Local water supplies must be respected and expression of thanks given for any help obtained from Non-members.  
  
e) the playing of loud music or unruly behaviour will not be accepted.
3. No firearms shall be used on any club outing without the express permission of the Leader.
4. Dogs are not permitted on any Trips without the express permission of the Trip Leader.
5. All rubbish shall be burnt, flattened and buried or taken away. Trip Leader to give instruction.
6. All hygiene decisions shall be made by the Leader.

At roadside stops the rule to be followed is:-

Ladies to the LEFT – Gents to the RIGHT

In all cases ALL WASTE, including paper shall be buried or removed for proper disposal.

7. All gates are to be left as found by the Leader.
8. Every care shall be exercised in the lighting and control of fires and all fires shall be properly extinguished on leaving the area.  
  
No fire to be lit in prohibited areas or during prohibited periods.
9. No member shall leave a trip or party without letting the Leader know and to state if the absence is to be permanent or not.
10. Name badges to be worn on all Club Meetings and Outings.

11. All members shall comply with the requirements of the Traffic Act and Regulations and observe road courtesy. This includes the consumption of Alcohol.
12. It shall be ascertained that no Member of a convoy is left in trouble without help. The convoy will stop until the vehicle is repaired or the vehicle is towed to a garage or town.
13. All vehicles shall carry sufficient fuel to proceed to the next CONVOY fuel stop.
14. All vehicles including your visitors must have a minimum of third party vehicle insurance.
15. All vehicles including your visitors must be roadworthy and be mechanically sound.
16. Swearing shall be reserved for situations that require it.
